Amend the amendment in section 1 in §1496-B by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

‘2. Other customer proprietary information. "Other customer proprietary information" means any information loaded, installed or otherwise placed on a wireless telephone or transmitted from a wireless telephone by a wireless telephone customer.’

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in §1496-B by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in §1496-C in subsection 1 in the last line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "State" the following: 'or any other customer proprietary information of any wireless telephone service customer or user in this State'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in §1496-C in subsection 2 in the last line (page 2, line 20 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "State" the following: 'or any other customer proprietary information of any wireless telephone service customer or user in this State'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in §1496-C in subsection 3 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 23 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "information" the following: 'or any other customer proprietary information'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds other customer proprietary information to the information that may not be sold or disclosed without permission. "Other customer proprietary information" is defined as any information loaded, installed or otherwise placed on a wireless telephone or transmitted from a wireless telephone by a wireless telephone customer.
