Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph V and inserting in its place the following:

'V. Study school <u>consolidationadministrative unit configuration</u> statewide, <u>develop a school</u> consolidation plan that includes criteria for evaluating opportunities for consolidation and, if desirable, develop a time line for implementation.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language relating to the power and duty of the State Board of Education to develop a school administrative unit configuration plan that includes criteria for evaluating opportunities for reconfiguration and, if desirable, develop a time line for implementation.
