An Act To Change the Charter of the St. Francis Water District Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1989, c. 51, §8, first sentence is amended to read:

All the affairs of the district shall beare managed by an elected board of trustees composed of 3 members of the legal voters of the district. One trustee may be a municipal officer of the Town of St. Francis. A trustee who is also a municipal officer shall abstain from any vote of municipal officers on a question relating to compensation of the trustees pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6410, subsection 7.
