Resolve, To Assist Veterans in Need of Shelter

- **Sec. 1 Maine State Housing Authority and homeless veterans. Resolved:** That the Maine State Housing Authority shall, with input from the Department of Veterans Affairs, assess the need for and placement of housing and shelter throughout the State for veterans of the United States Armed Forces who are homeless; and be it further
- **Sec. 2 Prioritization of projects. Resolved:** That the Maine State Housing Authority is directed to prioritize its projects to develop plans and financing to provide housing and shelter for homeless veterans of the State in cooperation with other public and private, national, state, regional and local agencies.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Maine State Housing Authority, with input from the Bureau of Veterans' Services within the Department of Veterans Affairs, to assess the need for and placement of housing and shelter throughout the State for homeless veterans and to make it a top priority to develop plans and work with local, state, regional and federal agencies to provide shelter and housing for homeless veterans.
