An Act To Ensure Retail Tobacco License Compliance

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4366-C, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

<u>2-A.</u> <u>Shipment only to licensed retailers.</u> <u>A distributor may not sell or offer to sell</u> <u>cigarettes to a retailer unless the retailer has provided documentation to the distributor that the retailer</u> <u>holds a current retail tobacco license issued under Title 22, section 1551-A.</u>

SUMMARY

This bill requires a tobacco retailer to document a current retail tobacco license before a distributor can ship cigarettes to that retailer. This bill ensures all tobacco retailers are licensed in order to purchase cigarettes from distributors to be sold at retail.
