## An Act Regarding Returnable Containers

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1865, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

**4. Font size; color.** The embossing, stamping, labeling or other method of secure attachment to the refundable beverage container required by this section must be done in letters and numbers at least 1/4 inch in height. The letters and numbers must be in an easily read font and of a color that is in sharp contrast to the background upon which they are embossed, stamped, labeled or attached.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect 180 days after approval.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires the letters and numbers of the refund value and the word "Maine" or "ME" placed on refundable beverage containers to be at least 1/4 inch in height, in a font style that is easily read and of a color that is in sharp contrast to the background on which the refund value and state designation are embossed, stamped, labeled or attached.
