Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the 6th paragraph the following:

Amend the bill in Part A in section 23 in §5218-B by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

3. <u>Additional credit.</u> <u>The base alternate household credit is increased by \$150 for each person</u> for whom the individual is entitled to claim an exemption as a dependent under the Code.'

Amend the bill in Part A in section 23 in §5218-B by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after §5218-C the following:

Amend the bill in Part A in section 32 in the first paragraph in the 7th line (page 11, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection 3," and inserting the following: 'subsection 4,'

Amend the bill in Part A in section 32 in the first paragraph in the 10th line (page 11, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection 3," and inserting the following: 'subsection 4,'

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part B.

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SUMMARY

This amendment provides for an additional credit of \$150 for each dependent when using alternate calculation of the household credit. This amendment also eliminates the changes proposed in the bill to the homestead property tax deduction.
