Amend the amendment on page 5 in §9724 in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 5, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2,000" and inserting the following: '5,000'

Amend the amendment on page 6 in section 4 in §2351 in the 2nd line (page 6, line 13 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2,000 inhabitants, and in every town of 2,000" and inserting the following: '~~2,000~~5,000 inhabitants, and in every town of ~~2,000~~5,000'

Amend the amendment on page 8 in §2373 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 8, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2,000" and inserting the following: '5,000'

Amend the amendment on page 8 in §2373 in the first paragraph in the 4th line (page 8, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2,000" and inserting the following: '5,000'

Amend the amendment on page 12 by inserting after section 21 the following:

This amendment changes the number of residents a municipality, town or city must have to enforce the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code and to appoint an inspector of buildings from 2,000 residents to 5,000 residents.
