An Act To Increase Reimbursement for Jury Duty

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1215, as amended by PL 1991, c. 528, Pt. E, §13 and affected by Pt. RRR and amended by c. 591, Pt. E, §13, is further amended to read:

§ 1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

A juror is entitled to paid mileage at the rate of $\frac{15 \notin 36 \notin}{15 \# 36 \#}$ per mile for travel expenses from the juror's residence to the place of holding court and return and to compensation at the rate of $\frac{10 \times 50}{10 \times 50}$ for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

SUMMARY

This bill raises the mileage paid a juror from 15ϕ a mile to 36ϕ a mile and raises the compensation from \$10 a day to \$50 for each day of required attendance at sessions of court.
