An Act To Prevent Overcharging for Prescription Drug Copayments Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2699, sub-§2, ¶H** is enacted to read:
- <u>H</u>. A pharmacy benefits manager or insurer shall require a contracted pharmacy to charge to an enrollee or insured person the pharmacy's usual and customary price of filling the prescription or the contracted copayment, whichever is less.
- **Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2699, sub-§5,** as enacted by PL 2003, c. 688, Pt. C, §10 and affected by §11, is repealed.
- **Sec. 3. Application.** That section of this Act that enacts the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 2699, subsection 2, paragraph H applies to contracts between a pharmacy benefits manager or insurer and a pharmacy executed or renewed on or after January 1, 2008.
