An Act Concerning Late Rent Fee Charges in Residential Tenancies

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6028, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 215, is amended to read:

1. Late payment. A payment of rent is late if it is not made within <u>157</u> days from the time the payment is due.

SUMMARY

This bill lowers the number of days from 15 to 7 before a fee can be charged for the late payment of rent.
