Amend the bill in section 5 in §2137 in the first indented paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2009" and inserting the following: '2010'

Amend the bill in section 6 in §7704 in the first indented paragraph in the first line (page 4, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2009" and inserting the following: '2010'

Amend the bill in section 8 in §1224 in the first indented paragraph in the first line (page 5, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2009" and inserting the following: '2010'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 8 the following:
