## An Act To Ensure That Substantial State Contracts Receive Adequate Legal Review

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1816-B is enacted to read:

## § 1816-B. Contract review

- 1. Review required. A department or agency of the State shall submit to the Attorney General for review and approval a proposed contract for the purchase of goods or services by that department or agency if the proposed contract:
  - A. Has a total contract price that exceeds \$3,000,000; or
  - B. Exposes the State to substantial risk in the event of nonperformance.

## **SUMMARY**

This bill requires state agencies and departments to submit to the Attorney General every proposed contract for the purchase of goods or services that has a total contract price that exceeds \$3,000,000 or that exposes the State to substantial risk in the event of nonperformance.
