An Act To Further Restrict the Availability of Methamphetamine and Amphetamine Pills

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1105-A, sub-§1, ¶G, as amended by PL 2001, c. 667, Pt. D, §24 and affected by §36, is further amended to read:

G. At the time of the offense, the person trafficks in methamphetamine <u>or amphetamine</u> in a quantity of <u>300 or more pills</u>, <u>capsules</u>, <u>tablets or units or</u> 100 grams or more. Violation of this paragraph is a Class A crime;

Effective 90 days following adjournment of the 125th Legislature, First Regular Session, unless otherwise indicated.
