## **State Mandates**

Required ActivityUnit AffectedLocal CostExpands the requirements in determining whether a student may attend a school in aSchoolModerate

school administrative unit other than the one in which the student has permanent residence as follows:

Moderate statewide

- 1) requires the superintendent to consult with knowledgeable employees of relevant school administrative units;
- 2) requires the school administrative unit to take reasonable steps to notify the parent or legal guardian of the student if they are not the ones initiating the request; and
- 3) requires the superintendent to make the determination within 10 calendar days of receiving the enrollment request.

Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the state from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional costs.

## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Additional cost to the Department of Education to develop the model for superintendents to use to explain the appeal process can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
