Fiscal Detail and Notes

The General Fund savings associated with limiting MaineCare reimbursement for methadone for the treatment of addiction to opioids to a lifetime maximum of 24 months is estimated to be \$1,492,428 in fiscal year 2012-13. The Federal Expenditures Fund share of the savings is estimated to be \$2,514,090 in fiscal year 2012-13.
