Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Health and Human Services will require Federal Block Grant Fund allocations of \$4,324,002 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$5,765,337 in fiscal year 2018-19 to provide Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) benefits and alternative aid benefits to 2-parent families and to increase from \$200 to \$300 the special housing allowance for families receiving TANF benefits.
