Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

Decreases Class E crimes.

A reduction in fines will decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill exempts a motor vehicle less than 12 years old from inspection and would result in a reduction in Highway Fund revenue of \$1,575,000 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$2,100,000 beginning in fiscal year 2018-19. This analysis assumes that 60% of all vehicles inspected are less than 12 years old.
