There are established 17 joint standing committees, which must be appointed at the commencement of the first regular session and which exercise jurisdiction in the following areas:

Agriculture, conservation and forestry

Appropriations and financial affairs

Criminal justice and public safety

Education and cultural affairs

Energy, utilities and technology

Environment and natural resources

Health and human services

Health coverage, insurance and financial services

Inland fisheries and wildlife

Innovation, development, economic advancement and commerce business

Judiciary

Labor and housing

Marine resources

State and local government

Taxation

Transportation

Veterans and legal affairs
