Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$29,027 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$58,342 in fiscal year 2020-21 to increase reimbursement rates for chiropractic services for manipulative treatments under procedure codes 98940, 98941 and 98942 to no less than 70% of the federal Medicare reimbursement rate. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
