#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$148,115 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$147,806 in fiscal year 2022-23 for the Department of Health and Human Services to amend its reimbursement rate under the MaineCare program for dental code 41899 to \$1,250 per procedure for freestanding ambulatory surgical centers performing procedures on the dentoalveolar structure. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also provided for the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) match.
