#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$470,831 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$469,618 in fiscal year 2022-23 due to the repeal of the requirements for a certificate of need issued by the Department of Health and Human Services for adding new licensed beds or increasing beds in a health care facility other than a hospital. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations are also included for the Nursing Facilities Tax.
