Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$55,612 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$111,224 in fiscal year 2022-23 for the reimbursement of a parent providing in-home personal care services to the parent's child by allowing the parent to register as a personal care agency. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
