Potential State Mandate - Unfunded

#### **State Mandates**

## **Required Activity**

Requires local school administrative units to assign content ratings for books or other written material in a school library that are not assigned a standard content rating and affix to the front cover of the book or written material a label indicating its assigned content rating. Also requires school administrative units to change the content rating for a book or written material if, after review, the Department of Education assigns a different rating.

**Unit Affected** Local Cost

School Moderate statewide

The required local activities in this bill may represent a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. If the bill does require a local unit of government to expand or modify its activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenue, the state mandate provisions of the Constitution of Maine require either: (1) General Fund appropriations be provided to fund at least 90% of any additional necessitated local costs of the mandate; or (2) a Mandate Preamble be added to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt the mandate from the funding requirement. If the bill does represent a state mandate and neither one of these actions occurs, the local units of government will not be required to implement the mandated activities.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Additional costs to the Department of Education associated with the rulemaking process can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
