26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33	This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs, adds an emergency preamble and clause to the bill, but retains the provision in the bill that the state contributions to teacher retirement, retired teachers' health insurance and retired teachers' life insurance may not be included in the calculation of the state share percentage of the total cost of funding public education from kindergarten to grade 12 as required by the Essential Programs and Services Funding Act. The amendment provides that the state share percentage target for fiscal year 2013-14 and succeeding years is 55%.
