6 7 8	There is established within the department an office to coordinate the efforts of law enforcement, health care and treatment programs and education initiatives to combat addiction to opiates as defined in Title 17-A, section 1101, subsection 7.

.0	This bill establishes an office within the Department of Health and Human Services to coordinate efforts in the State to combat addiction to opiates.
