6 This amendment is the majority report of the committee and clarifies that a school administrative unit is not required to use student growth measures in educator evaluation 7 requirements and provides that the effective date of the provisions in the legislation that 8 remove the requirement regarding student growth and learning systems is September 1, 9 This amendment also requires that a school administrative unit's steering 10 2021. committee on the elements of the school administrative unit's performance evaluation and 11 professional growth system must include a majority of teachers chosen by the school 12 13 administrative unit's local union and that any revisions to the performance evaluation and professional growth system made by the steering committee must be reached by 14 15 consensus.
