I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2103, sub-§4, ¶¶C and D, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 568, §1, are amended to read:
4 5	C. A driver's license solely to verify that a commercial driver's license has been issued and only if the person making the photocopy is an employer; or
6 7	D. A driver's license solely for motor vehicle loaner and demonstration purposes pursuant to sections 1002 and 1003-; or
8	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2103, sub-§4, ¶E is enacted to read:
9 10	E. A driver's license solely for legal purposes, as long as the photocopy is made by an attorney.

12 13	This bill allows an attorney to photocopy a driver's license for legal purposes without the permission of the Secretary of State.
