1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-QQ is enacted to read:
3	§3174-QQ. Care for children with life-threatening conditions
4 5 6 7	The department shall make decisions approving or disapproving care or services for children with life-threatening conditions who are members in the MaineCare program within one working day of receiving a complete request or order from the health care provider for the child.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to make decisions approving or disapproving MaineCare care or services for children with life-threatening conditions within one working day of receiving the complete request or order.
