1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to require a law enforcement officer who has administered
6	naloxone hydrochloride to a person to provide the name and contact information for that
7	person to the nearest publicly funded mental health treatment provider. It requires a
8	treatment provider receiving that information to contact the person and inform the person
9	of available options regarding drug addiction treatment.
