1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §709 is enacted to read:
3	§709. Historic preservation
4 5 6 7 8	Any construction or maintenance of a highway that receives federal funds under section 57 or is a federal aid highway under this Title must comply with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and any supporting federal regulations if the construction or maintenance involves or affects a structure or place listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires the Department of Transportation to comply with the National
11	Historic Preservation Act when performing construction or maintenance on a federal aid
12	highway that involves or affects a structure or place listed on the National Register of
13	Historic Places.
