1	Sec. 1. Signs placed for Hebron Academy. Resolved: That the Department
2	of Transportation, notwithstanding national guidelines relating to directional signs for
3	highways, shall place directional signs on Interstate 95 at the northbound and southbound
4	exits of the highway that are located closest to Hebron Academy and that Hebron
5	Academy shall assume all costs associated with the directional signs.
6	SUMMARY
7	This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to place directional signs on
0	Interstate 05 of the northbound and southbound axits of the highway that are located

Interstate 95 at the northbound and southbound exits of the highway that are located
closest to Hebron Academy and Hebron Academy to assume all costs associated with the
directional signs.
