6	3. Transfer or furnish. Transfer or furnish harvested marijuana to another person;
7 8	<b>Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §2423-D, sub-§4,</b> as enacted by PL 2017, c. 452, §7, is repealed.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill repeals the provision of the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act that
11	requires visiting qualifying patients to designate a registered caregiver or dispensary in
12	order to obtain harvested marijuana.
