1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1019-B, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	<u>6.</u> Independent expenditure limits. For each election cycle, as defined in section 1122, subsection 3-A, aggregate independent expenditures required to be reported under subsection 4 are limited as follows:
6	A. For a candidate for Governor, \$7,500;
7	B. For a candidate for State Senator, \$5,000; and
8	C. For a candidate for State Representative, \$2,500.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill limits independent expenditures for candidates for Governor, State Senator and State Representative.
