The purpose of the program is to assist eligible students and families with accessing housing assistance programs pursuant to Title 20-A, section 4014.		
25 26 27	2. Eligibility. The Maine State Housing Authority shall, upon the referral of an eligible student and family by a local educational agency liaison, assist the student and family with accessing housing assistance programs pursuant to Title 20-A, section 4014.

A maximum of \$2,000,000 in funding for the program must be allocated to the fund established in section 4766 from funds provided to the State by the Federal Government pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, to the extent the funds are eligible to be used for the purposes of the program in accordance with federal law and regulations.		

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4. Rules. The Maine State Housing Authority may adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

§4766. Homeless Student Assistance Program Fund

The Homeless Student Assistance Program Fund is established as a nonlapsing fund within the Maine State Housing Authority. The Maine State Housing Authority may apply money in the fund for purposes authorized by this subchapter.

Initiative: Provides one-time funds in fiscal year 2021-22 and fiscal year 2022-23 only to assist eligible students and families with accessing housing assistance programs.
