An Act To Facilitate MaineCare-Funded Assisted Living by Providing a Cost-of-living Adjustment to Private Nonmedical Institutions and Adult Family Care Homes

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Annual cost-of-living adjustment. The Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules in Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 2, Adult Family Care Services and Chapter III, Section 97, Appendix C: Principles of Reimbursement for Medical and Remedial Service Facilities and in the department's rule Chapter 115: Principles of Reimbursement for Residential Care Facilities - Room and Board Costs to provide for ongoing, annual rate changes to adjust for inflation. For the state fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the amount of the adjustment is 4%. For each year thereafter, the department shall set the inflation adjustment cost-of-living percentage change in reimbursement in accordance with the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index medical care services index.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
