1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6088 is enacted to read:
3	§6088. Municipal fees
4 5 6	A municipality in whose jurisdiction a lease is granted under this subchapter may assess a reasonable fee to a person granted the lease to pay for the municipality's administrative costs associated with the lease.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill allows a municipality to charge a reasonable fee to a person granted a Department of Marine Resources aquaculture lease on or under coastal waters to pay for the municipality's administrative costs associated with the lease.
