13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17	Whereas, under current law, veterans in the State experiencing crises are eligible to receive financial assistance, distributed by the Director of the Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services; and
18 19	Whereas, the Director of the Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services currently has no authority to administer emergency funds; and
20 21	Whereas, funds recently appropriated for the purpose of providing veterans with this financial assistance must be placed in a fund to be administered by the director; and
22 23	Whereas, veterans are experiencing crises now, for which financial assistance is immediately necessary; and
24 25 26 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
28	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:
29	'Sec. 4. 37-B MRSA §505, sub-§1-B is enacted to read:
30 31 32 33 34	1-B. Veterans Temporary Emergency Assistance Fund. The Veterans Temporary Emergency Assistance Fund, referred to in this section as "the fund," is established as a dedicated, nonlapsing Other Special Revenue Funds account in the bureau. The fund is administered and used by the director for the purposes of offering financial assistance to veterans as prescribed by subsection 1-A, paragraphs A and B.

- 1 Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:
 - 'Sec. 6. Maine Revised Statutes amended; revision clause. Wherever in the Maine Revised Statutes the words "Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services" appear, they are amended to read "Maine Bureau of Veterans' Services" and the Revisor of Statutes shall implement this revision when updating, publishing or republishing the statutes.
 - Sec. 7. Transfer from General Fund unappropriated surplus; Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, Veterans Temporary Emergency Assistance Fund. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$375,000 from the General Fund unappropriated surplus to the Veterans Temporary Emergency Assistance Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management no later than June 30, 2017.
