2 3	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4722, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 859, Pt. C, §§5 and 7, is amended to read:
4 5	B. Social studies and history, including American history and government, including at least one course in civics and government2 years;

7 8	This bill requires a secondary student to satisfactorily complete at least one course in civics and government to receive a high school diploma.
