1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and Whereas, senior citizens are often the targets of fraudulent and exploitive financial 3 4 schemes: and 5 Whereas, personal financial management assistance for those senior citizens who are no longer able to manage their finances could decrease the number of senior citizens 6 7 who are taken advantage of financially and allow them to continue to live independently; 8 and 9 Whereas, this legislation provides such assistance and needs to take effect as soon 10 as possible to prevent further abuse; and Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 11 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 12 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 13 14 therefore, Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 15 16 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §5114, sub-§2, ¶¶F and G as enacted by PL 1973, c. 630, §1, 17 are amended to read. 18 F. Services designed to assist older persons in avoiding institutionalization, including evaluation and screening and home health services; or 19 20 G.
