The amendment clarifies that a retired state employee or retired teacher who returns to service as a classroom-based employee or school administrator is entitled to the same normal retirement cost contributions that the employer and the employee are required to provide to the Maine Public Employees Retirement System that would be required for the position if the position were filled by an employee who is not a retired state employee or retired teacher.
