25	§490-XX. Prohibition on hydraulic fracturing
26 27	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person may not perform or cause to be performed hydraulic fracturing in the State.
28	§490-YY. Prohibition on importation of wastes from hydraulic fracturing
29 30	Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a person may not transport any hydraulic fracturing wastewater, waste product or by-product resulting from

1	hydraulic fracturing exploration or production into the State for the purpose of treatment,
2	discharge, disposal or storage.'
3	SUMMARY
4	This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the title,
5	removes the emergency preamble and clause and replaces the bill. It prohibits hydraulic
6	fracturing in the State and prohibits the transportation of hydraulic fracturing wastewater,
7	waste products or by-products into the State for the purpose of treatment, discharge,
8	disposal or storage.
