17 18	Whereas, it is critically important to implement this authority as soon as possible in order to increase the availability of mental health services; and
19 20 21 22	<b>Whereas,</b> in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
23	Amend the amendment by adding before the summary the following:
24 25	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
