1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§1, ¶B,** as amended by PL 2009, c. 156, §1, is 3 further amended to read: 4 B. "Recreational or harvesting activities" means recreational activities conducted 5 out-of-doors, including, but not limited to, agritourism activity, hunting, fishing, trapping, camping, environmental education and research, hiking, recreational caving, 6 7 sight-seeing, operating snow-traveling and all-terrain vehicles, skiing, hang-gliding, 8 noncommercial aviation activities, dog sledding, equine activities, boating, sailing, canoeing, rafting, biking, picnicking, swimming or activities involving the harvesting 9 10 or gathering of forest, field or marine products. It includes entry of, volunteer maintenance and improvement of, use of and passage over premises in order to 11 pursue these activities. "Recreational or harvesting activities" does not include 12 commercial agricultural or timber harvesting. 13 14 Sec. 2. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§1, ¶D is enacted to read: D. "Agritourism activity" means an activity carried out on a farm that allows 15 members of the general public, for recreational, entertainment or educational 16 purposes, to view or participate in rural activities, including farming, ranching, rural 17 18 history, rural culture and harvest-your-own activities and similar rural activities and attractions. "Agritourism activity" includes an activity involving an animal exhibition 19 at an agricultural fair licensed by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural 20 21 Resources under Title 7, section 83. 22 Sec. 3. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§4, ¶B, as amended by PL 1995, c. 566, §1, is 23 further amended to read: 24 B. For an injury suffered in any case where permission to pursue any recreational or 25 harvesting activities was granted for a consideration other than the consideration, if any, paid to the following: 26 27 (1) The landowner or the landowner's agent by the State; or 28 (2) The landowner or the landowner's agent for use of the premises on which the 29 injury was suffered, as long as the premises are not used primarily for 30 commercial recreational purposes and as long as the user has not been granted the exclusive right to make use of the premises for recreational activities; or 31 32 (3) The landowner or the landowner's agent for participation in an agritourism 33 activity; or

SUMMARY

This bill provides limited liability to landowners who open their land for agritourism
