1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §2951, sub-§6, as repealed and replaced by PL 2017, c. 342, §2, is amended to read:
4 5	6. Student assessment <u>and other requirements</u> . <u>Meets At a minimum, meets or</u> <u>exceeds</u> the following requirements:
6 7	A. It participates in the statewide assessment program to measure and evaluate the academic achievements of students; and
8 9	B. It meets the applicable requirements of <u>and has a curriculum aligned with</u> the system of learning results established in section 6209-:
10	C. It meets health and safety requirements applicable to public schools;
11	D. It accepts any Maine student from a sending school administrative unit; and
12 13	E. It enters into a contract with every sending school administrative unit of a student who is attending the private school.
14 15 16	The requirements of this subsection apply only to a school that enrolls 60% or more publicly funded students, as determined by the previous year's October and April average enrollment; and
17 18	Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to school years beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year.
19	SUMMARY
20 21	This bill amends the requirements that must be met by private schools receiving public funds for tuition purposes.
