2 Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2119, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

8

4. Exemption. This section does not apply to a person who is an emergency medical
services' person as defined in Title 32, section 83, subsection 12, a firefighter as defined
in Title 25, section 1611, subsection 4 or a law enforcement officer as defined in Title 25,
section 3701, subsection 3 while that person is acting in the course of that person's duties
as an emergency medical services' person, firefighter or law enforcement officer.

SUMMARY

9 This bill provides an exemption to the prohibition against text messaging while 10 operating a motor vehicle for emergency medical services' persons, firefighters and law 11 enforcement officers acting in the course of their duties.
