1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, behavioral health services are important for an individual's overall health and well-being; and 4 5 Whereas, Riverview Psychiatric Center is an integral part of the behavioral health system in the State; and 6 7 Whereas, this legislation provides funding for an immediate increase to wages for employees of the Riverview Psychiatric Center, including the Outpatient Services team; 8 9 10 Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period in order for the funding to be provided as soon as possible during this biennium; and 11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 12 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 13 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 14 15 therefore, 16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 17 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.
