**An Act To Allow the State's Adult Use Marijuana Tracking System  
To Track Plants and Products by Group**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-B MRSA §105, sub-§1-A** is enacted to read:

3 **1-A. Group tracking.** The tracking system must allow for the tracking of a group  
4 that includes:

5 A. Marijuana plants planted in the same area at the same time;

6 B. Marijuana plants transplanted to the same area at the same time;

7 C. Marijuana plants planted in and marijuana plants transplanted to the same area at  
8 the same time;

9 D. Marijuana plants of multiple types that the licensee has designated as a group for  
10 the purpose of tracking; or

11 E. Marijuana products that the licensee has designated as a group for the purpose of  
12 tracking.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows the system administered by the Department of Administrative and  
15 Financial Services for tracking adult use marijuana plants and products to track groups of  
16 plants or products.
