15 16 17	Whereas, the September 16, 2019 explosion in Farmington demonstrates the tragic consequences that can result from unmarked underground liquefied propane gas pipes; and
18 19	Whereas, the exemption of certain underground liquefied propane gas facilities from the so-called dig safe law poses a clear danger to excavators and the public; and
20 21 22 23	Whereas, this legislation must take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period to address, as soon as possible, this significant safety risk by making liquefied propane gas distribution systems that have underground pipes subject to the so-called dig safe law; and
24 25 26 27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
28	Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:
29 30	' Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
31 32	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
