29 30	This amendment expands the use of funds to support shelter operations at all emergency homeless shelters, not just low-barrier emergency shelters as proposed in the

bill. It also allows the Maine State Housing Authority to allocate funds to shelters using
the funding formula methodology for shelter operations from its Homeless Solutions
Rule.
